JOB TITLE:

Head of Development

OBJECTIVE:

To operate a Player & Coach Development Program for the club.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

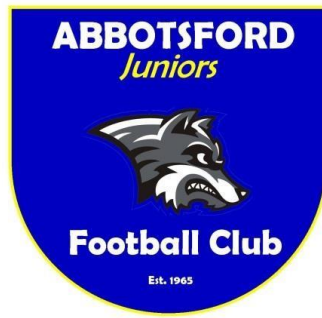
- Coordinate grading sessions for all Boys & Girls junior teams U17 and lower (as required) and oversee the selection of all Development teams.
- Operate player Development Program on behalf of the club.
- Manage Third Party provider relationships, involved in the delivery of the club's player Development Program.
- Appoint coaches & assistant coaches to all Development teams throughout the club.
- Deliver Coaching courses as required.
- Support coaches & assistant coaches throughout the season.

RELATIONSHIPS:

- Reports to the President and General Committee.
- Third Party providers supporting the delivery of the player Development Program.
- Secretary and Competition Secretary with regards to entering teams into appropriate levels of competition for the teams' abilities.
- CDSFA Community Coaching coordinator.
- NSW Coaching Director and Staff.

ACCOUNTABILITY:

- It is the responsibility of the Head of Development to coordinate appropriate grading sessions, thereby ensuring that Development Teams are selected in accordance with the Club's Grading Policy.
- Ensure all Development teams have a coach & an assistant coach in place, who are qualified and suitable to coach that level team.



- Should report to the Development Team coaches and the General Committee to ensure all members are aware of any upcoming coaching courses available etc.

The estimated time commitment required as the Head of Development is up to 4-6 hours per week around peak periods such as the Grading period and the commencement of the Development Program activities. Away from these times, it would decrease.

- Consistently demonstrates alignment to the Club's Purpose and Values.
- Holds or is working towards holding the FFA/AFC "C" Youth Licence accreditation.
- Passionate about and dedicated to developing the club's junior players.
- Willing to work with other coaches to share knowledge and assist with any problems / questions.
